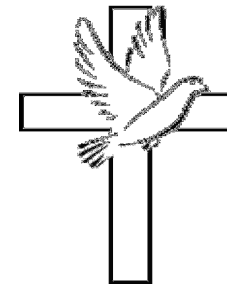

DIOCESAN AND DEANERY EVENTS.

PROCLAIM: Come Holy Spirit! Pope Francis has said we mustn't be inward-focussed and self-referential. He has expressed his vision statement in 'Evangelii Gaudium': 'I dream of a 'missionary option,' that is, a missionary impulse capable of transforming everything, so that the Church's customs, ways of doing things, times and schedules, language and structures, can be suitably channelled for the evangelisation of today's world rather than for her self-preservation.' Let us pray today for a new out pouring of the Holy Spirit. We wait with expectant faith in the upper room, but we do not stay there, filled anew let us follow the Spirit, and proclaim with Peter the Good News of salvation!

Exploring St Mark's Gospel: On Wednesday 27th May at the Church of the Immaculate Conception, Stroud @ 7.30pm; John Huntriss will be deepening our understanding of the Jesus we encounter in St Mark's Gospel. This short time together will invite participants to familiarise themselves with Mark's Gospel as they journey through the liturgical year. This might be an ideal opportunity for your parish RCIA groups or your parish readers to come together as part of their formation. Fr Chris **Baptismal Preparation:** Exploring Baptismal Preparation; Fr John McLoughlin and Veronica Murphy from the Archdiocese of Liverpool have produced superb catechetical formation material they have produced to prepare families for the baptism of their children. The material is designed to support families in their preparation for their child's baptism as well as immerse them in a welcoming community of faith that seeks to support and nurture them. The two sessions will take place at St Patrick's Church, Brockworth on Wednesday 3 June (7.30pm to 9.15pm with refreshment available from 7pm) and on Thursday 4 June (11.00am to 1pm, followed by a sandwich lunch). The same session introducing the catechetical material will be run twice. The sessions are open to priests, deacons, catechists, pastoral assistants, and those good people of faith and a genuine sense of welcome that you feel would form part of a formation team that would journey with parents, families, and godparents in preparation for Baptism in your parishes.
