First Reading: 1 Kings 19:16,19-21 *Elisha leaves the plough to follow Elijah*

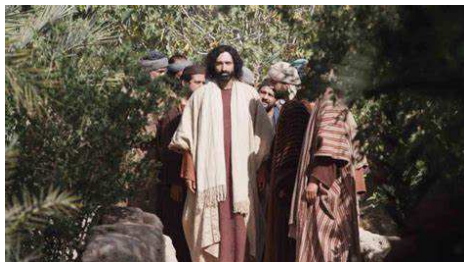
Resp. Psalm: O Lord, it is You Who are my portion
