THE ADVENT PRESERVATION SOCIETY The world around us would have us believe that the season of Christmass is already in full swing. Their version has no Christ and no Mass!! The lights in the streets are to invite us to late night shopping and spending. The world around us says that buying presents rather than giving them is what it is all about. The Christmas Season began for some in September and for many more as soon as Halloween was over on the 1st November. It will all be over as soon as His Majesty the King makes his annual broadcast on the afternoon of December 25th. They do not preserve Advent and they don't keep Christmass at Christmastide. Advent runs up to it getting dark on Christmas Eve. ADVENT II This is a season of expectation and waiting with hope. "Advent" means "arrival" or "coming," and it prompts us to pause each day in December and remember why Jesus came/comes/will come again and why we should come to Him. The Advent wreath is originally a German custom. Its sole purpose is for counting the Sundays before Christmas arrives and it is made out of evergreens. Advent candles shine brightly in the midst of darkness, symbolizing and reminding us that Jesus came as Light into our dark world. The circle reminds us of God's unending love and the eternal life He makes possible. Attending Church during Advent we can sit in silence, away the commercial world in which we live in.
