

They are solemnly sung at either end of the Gospel Canticle Magnificat. the high point of Vespers or Evening Prayer. They also form the Alleluia Verse each day at Mass. These ancient compositions are woven from Old Testament quotations and tell us about Who the Messiah will turn out to be :the Wisdom of God in human flesh, Lord of Sinai & Giver of the Law of Moses, The Key and Prince of David's royal line, the Promised Root of Jesse, the Rising Sun The King of the Nations,



Most of us remember these as the verses of

God with us.

O Come, O Come Emmanuel, which we will sing with gusto this Sunday.
