EPIPHANY THEMES AND THE 2ND PART OF CHRISTMAS-TIDE:

With the Solemnity of Epiphany, Christmas Time moves into its second part. It is often quite short and gets easily overlooked. The Second Part focusses on the showing forth to the world of the truth of Christ's Incarnation. The Visit of the Wise Men is only one Bible scene used to do this. The Baptism of the Lord is another, anciently kept on the 13th January. The Miracle at Cana and the Multiplication of the Loaves are also used to make the same points.
