<u>THOUGHT OF THE WEEK</u> St Benedict of Nursia died on the 21st March 550AD. This date is always in Lent and in recent decades, he has been kept in July, on the anniversary of the translation of his relics in France. The sons and daughters of St Benedict have had a huge influence on the culture, music, agriculture, cuisine and scientific knowledge of Europe and so he is venerated as a Co-Patron of the Continent.
