

Luke 14:25-33 - Jesus talks about the cost of discipleship with startling honesty. Being a disciple could mean division, separation even from loved ones because loyalty to Christ has to take precedence over the dearest loyalties of this world. To choose Christ could mean denial of other things and other loyalties!

The disciple must be ready to take up the cross, to be regarded as a criminal and to die, no glory, no fame, no name, no wealth... no pretences!

Jesus calls us to break out of our safe and comfortable zones into new and challenging life-style, a "cross-bearing" way of life... A cross-bearing way of life involves denial of self in the service of God.

Discipleship means dying to self so as to live for Christ. It means following his plan rather than our

own agenda and obedience to His will and wisdom. To be obedient requires openness to hardship and suffering...

Be prepared to welcome and accept the pain and the loss that come with being faithful to your call...

Being a disciple has its cost. But it is worth investing, worth sacrifice. Invest yourself into loving God and God's people!
