

THE FEAST OF THE EXALTATION OF THE HOLY CROSS



Dear Friends,

John 3:13-17 - There is an ancient story about an old man saving a scorpion. While meditating under a tree on the bank of the Ganges, an old man saw a scorpion floating helplessly on the river. He stretched himself out and reached out to rescue the drowning scorpion. The scorpion stung him as soon as he touched it. The old man kept trying in spite of being stung over and over again. A passerby, who witnessed it, asked the old man why he was saving a creature that was stinging him. His reply was, "it is the scorpion's nature to sting, but it is my nature to save". Whatever the hurt, the old man was going to remain faithful to his nature to save. He was going to save a creature that was fighting back.

God has reached out again and again even when we continued to strike back. It is God's nature to save. It is God's nature, God's character, the very essence of God's being to redeem, to save, to love and to heal. We fail to respond, we often strike back like the scorpion in the above story, and we remain ungrateful. God does not simply love... God is love. "God loved the world so much that he gave his only son..." (Jn.3:16). "The son of man must be lifted up so that everyone who believes in him may have eternal life." Today is the remembrance of the Cross. The cross, the sign of punishment and scandal became the sign of salvation. God uses even the signs of punishment and scandal as agents of healing, redemption, salvation, love and Grace.

Trust in the transforming power of God. God transforms even forces of evil into agents of healing and wholeness.

DOUBLE CELEBRATIONS AT ST. PETER'S!






REMEMBERING PATRICIA FLETCHER
